Dear Parents/Guardians,

Visit to Tuppenny Barn, Emsworth

As part of our 'Can We Dig It?' topic, we have organised for Year 3 to visit Tuppenny Barn in Emsworth on Tuesday 5th June and Friday 8th June. Madagascar class and half of Morocco class will visit on Tuesday 5th June while Egypt class and the other half of Morocco class will visit on Friday 8th June. A further letter will be sent nearer the time to advise which day your child will be going if they are in Morocco class.

The children will be learning about how organic produce is cultivated and harvested. They will also have the opportunity to get involved in activities which promote the benefits of growing, cooking and eating healthy foods. The children will find out where fruit and vegetables come from, learning the skills needed to grow and prepare their own meals.

We plan to leave promptly at 9.00 and return to school by 3.15. The children will therefore, need to be in school by 8.40 on the morning of their visit.

- For our visit to Tuppenny Barn the children may wear their own clothes with a **school sweatshirt or cardigan** and, as most of this trip will be spent outside, they will also need a **waterproof coat, sun hat, sun cream** and **sturdy shoes or trainers**.
- If your child normally has a hot school meal, please cancel it for this day. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, Chartwells will provide a packed lunch, which will contain a roll, fruit, cookie or muffin and a drink. You may, of course, provide your child with extra food. This needs to be in a plastic bag so that after lunch it can be disposed of at the barn.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £12.80 to cover the cost of the trip. The children will not need any extra money on the day. Although the contribution is voluntary, it should be pointed out that the visit could not take place unless all parents, who are able, are willing to contribute.

Payment and completed consent forms will need to be returned by Tuesday 22nd May. Where possible, we would ask parents to use ParentPay to make this contribution. Please ask at the office if you need help or have lost your activation letter. If you use ParentPay, you give consent online and do not need to return the slip.

We now keep an annual pupil medical consent form in the office and a copy of this will be held by the trip leader. If you have not completed a medical form or your child's medical circumstances have changed please request an update form from the office.



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We appreciate that some families might find it particularly difficult to contribute all or part of the suggested sum. If you are in this position and have need of financial assistance, please apply in confidence to Mrs Brotherton in the school office.

It should also be stressed that if a family were unable to contribute, and the trip were still to proceed, no child within the year group for whom the trip is intended will be disadvantaged and be left out of the activity.
