From Thursday 5th October 2017, we will be starting the Weald Book Awards Reading Club. The Weald Book Awards is an event held around World Book Day where The Weald and local primary schools vote and choose a favourite book out of 6 nominations. The club will run between 3.30 and 4.15pm every Thursday in the Year 6 classrooms and each week the children will be reading one of the 6 books, completing some activities based on the book and discussing what they have read with their peers. At intervals throughout the year, all children from schools participating will meet together and they will have the opportunity to meet some of the authors of the books. It's a great opportunity for our students to really work in-depth with interesting, and at times, challenging material.

The books have been assessed by the teaching staff at BPS and been deemed suitable for year 6 children, but if you would like to judge for yourself we will be reading the following texts:
