<p><b><u>Chinese Dragons</u></b> In China a dragon is a symbol of power, strength and good luck. Can you find China on a world map? Use the internet or a book to find out what Chinese dragons look like?</p> 	<p><b><u>Create a mythical beast</u></b> Choose three animals and combine a part of each of these to create a new creature. What will your new beast be called? Why did you choose the three animals?</p>	<p><b><u>Mythical creature egg</u></b> Design and create a mythical beast's egg. Think about what kind of creature it will hatch into and how the colours/decorations will suggest this. Include some information about the type of beast your egg will be.</p>	<p><b><u>Poets corner.</u></b> Back by popular demand! Write a poem or song about a mythical beast. You could learn this off my heart and recite/sing it to your friends/class.</p> 	<p><b><u>St George.</u></b> Research St George using books or the internet. Present the information you find out in any way you like such as writing a story, making a fact page or a documentary.</p>

Don't forget a story has five parts! Why don't you make a book with illustrations?</p> 	<p><b><u>Dragon nest maths</u></b> Mrs Dragon has some eggs. She puts them in egg boxes. Each egg box holds 6 eggs but when she fills the boxes, she has 1 left over. How many eggs does Mrs Dragon have? How many answers can you find?</p>	<p><b><u>Dragon words</u></b> How many words can you write using the letters in the word DRAGON? e.g. on, rag</p> 	<p><b><u>Design a game for a Luna</u></b> Can you design a game for Luna to play with Franklin? It could be anything from a card game to a board game like "Snakes and Ladders."</p>
