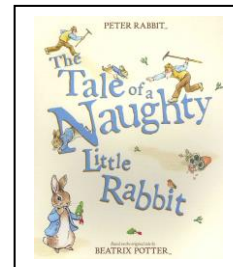


In an English Country Garden
