### Welcome to your Autumn Term Homework.

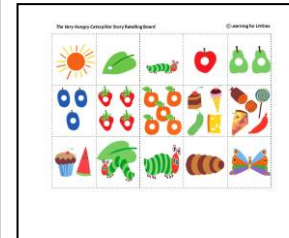
