## **Mathematics**

As mathematicians, we will be comparing and discussing composition of numbers to 8. We will also be investigating capacity and weight.

## Communication and language

We will provide a language rich environment for the children to develop their back and forth interactions. New vocabulary around nursery rhymes and days of celebration will be introduced and used.

## <u>Literacy</u>

As writers, we are going to form our own sentences using our phonological knowledge by describing a dragon and using rhyming words. We will also decode words to develop our reading skills in small groups.

### Physical development

We will be focusing on hand-eye co-ordination, spatial awareness, agility and co-ordination by using ours hands to develop our ball control.



#### Personal, social and emotional

Through our work on nursery rhymes, the children will learn to how to manage their emotions and develop a positive sense of self, accepting that all feelings are valid; it's how we react to them.

# Understanding the world

We will be looking at different celebrations from the past, such as Shrove Tuesday, and celebrations from around the world, including Chinese New Year.

## Expressive arts and design

We will have regular opportunities to engage with the arts, using this to express ourselves. We will share our creations and explain how they were made. As part of our nursery rhymes theme, we will recount the rhymes in our own words.
