Let us know

Where does your story begin? Where is your animal going? Why?
What will they meet?

Make some groups.

Find a nice pile of socks.
How many did you start with?
Put the socks in groups of 2.
How many groups have you made?
Try recording what you did as a number sentence.



Investigate

See if you can find out how many oceans and seas there are on our planet. Which is the largest? Smallest?

Draw a map?

Draw a map of a journey you have taken. Perhaps it could be your journey to school or a walk you went on.
What did you pass on the journey?
Where did you start and finish?

Make it!

Make a home for a creature to live in. What will they need and how big does it need to be?
Will it be for a bird, reptile, insect or mammal?
Where would be the best place for it to be to encourage something to live in it?

Cook something with an adult that is made from a vegetable.
Do you need to cook it or is it a raw vegetable?
