| <p><u>What happened when?</u></p> <p>Create a timeline of when William Shakespeare wrote his plays. Remember that there were 37 plays in total.</p> | <p><u>Feeling Creative?</u></p> <p>Make a drawing, painting or collage using different materials that shows a scene from Macbeth.</p> | <p><u>Writing to entertain...</u></p> <p>Write a narrative based on one of Shakespeare's plays. You can use the narrative versions of Macbeth we have looked at in school to help you.</p> |
| <p><u>Who's who?</u></p> <p>Make a one page profile about William Shakespeare or a character from a Shakespeare play.</p> | <p><u>"To be, or not to be?"</u></p> <p>Learn and memorise a famous passage from a Shakespeare play of your choice. Prepare this at home and ask your teacher if you would like to perform this to your class.</p> | <p><u>Set design</u></p> <p>In a small box create a 3D set design for a scene from Macbeth.</p> |
| <p><u>Famous Scientists</u></p> <p>Write a report as Charles Darwin or Mary Anning based on their discoveries related to fossils, adaptation and evolution.</p> | <p><u>Fossil of the future</u></p> <p>Using your knowledge of how fossils are formed, design and create a fossil of the future. Think about which items humans use that might be fossilised. Be creative with how you make your fossil.</p> | <p><u>Computing Animation</u></p> <p>Use www.flipanim.com to make your own animation at home. Use the skills you have learnt in school and practise these at home. Once you have finished your animation, download and email it to the Year 6 email.</p> |
| <p><u>Rules of Rounders</u></p> <p>Create an infographic explaining the rules and tactics of Rounders.</p> | <p><u>Gap Facts</u></p> <p>Practice your Gap Facts at home so that you know them from memory. Remember that you need to say the whole calculation and recall the 2 multiplication and 2 division facts for each times table.</p> | <p><u>Free choice...</u></p> <p>Follow your own interests and ideas linked to any area of learning we have covered in school.
