Enjoy reading the books you have found and share your favourite books with us.</p> 	<p><u>Design and Technology</u> Design and make a shield for a knight.</p> 	<p><u>Castle designer</u> Design your ideal castle. Present your idea through drawings, sculpture or writing.</p> 
<p><u>Cooking/Maths</u> Bread was a popular food choice during Medieval times and the cooks of the castle would have baked it themselves. Research medieval bread recipes and get baking! Remember to measure your ingredients carefully.</p>	<p><u>History Research</u> Research a king or queen from the past and find facts about them. Choose how to present the information e.g. a PowerPoint, fact file, poster.</p> 	<p><u>Royal Banquet</u> Create your own medieval banquet.
