The Daily Routine

- · 9:00 9:30 Guided Reading
- · 9.30-9.45 mental maths
- 9:30 12:00 morning sessions
- · 10:30-10:45 Playtime
- · 12:00 12:55 Lunchtime
- · 12:55 3:15 Afternoon sessions
- Assemblies will take place daily.
- Flexible Fridays independent learning and outdoor learning opportunities.



Transition from Year One

- We continue to encourage the children to be independent and responsible.
- We will build on the skills and experiences that children have developed in Year 1.
- The children will still take part in self initiated, and independent activities.
- We give the children opportunities to use the outdoor environment.





Guided Reading

- We use the Read, Write Inc. scheme continuing from Year 1. Most children will progress onto non-scheme books.
- We do need your help. If you can spare some time to help with the guided reading please sign up. We need 3 adults per class every morning if possible.
- The children also take part in weekly 'Book Talk' sessions.

Reading at school and at home

- Fluency
- Discussion
- Expression
- · Understanding (retrieval, inference and evaluation skills)



Home reading books

- Enjoying books together is so important and we want to encourage children's love of reading at home.
- The children will choose from an appropriate selection of books and are encouraged to take responsibility for changing their books.
- Please use the new 'Reading Journal' to record what your child is reading every day.
- The children will continue to choose a book from the library to bring home.

Home reading books

- · Children can change their books daily
- Some books may challenge the children more than others and will take longer to read. Please take your time to explore the book together.



Maths

- · Daily 15 minute mental maths sessions help with fluency and develop the children's resilience for using mental strategies.
- · Children will investigate a variety of maths problems linked to everyday

life.

Helping at home



- Practise quick recall of number bonds to 10, 20 and 100
- Use games, songs and the Times
 Table Rock Star program to:
- Learn the multiplication facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times table
- Learn the related division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times table

What else will your child learn in Year 2?

- There will be half termly or termly themes covering all areas of the curriculum
- Overviews will be sent to you showing what the children will be doing
- Your expertise/knowledge is very welcome in the classroom so please let us know if there is something you could share with the children.




Homework
