School Uniform

The uniform colours are royal blue, white and grey. The following are the recommended items for children to wear.

Winter Uniform

White blouse/polo shirt with or without logo
Royal blue jumper / cardigan

Grey skirt / pinafore dress
White or Grey socks

Summer Uniform

Royal Blue gingham checked / striped dress
White / Grey socks
Flat sandals / black shoes (No heels)
Royal blue jumper / cardigan

Winter Uniform

Grey trousers
Black shoes (No heels)
Trainers may only be worn for P.E.
Royal blue, grey or white tights

Summer Uniform

White short sleeved shirt with or without logo
Short grey trousers
Trainers may only be worn for P.E.

Trainers are only permitted for outdoor PE sessions and may not be worn in school. Any child arriving in trainers will be asked to change their shoes: black plimsolls will be provided if needed for the child to wear for that day.

All children need to bring a raincoat/waterproof throughout the year.

PE Kit - All children:

White T-shirt Navy/dark blue shorts (No 'Skorts')

A house coloured t-shirt can be ordered from our uniform website once the house allocation has been made

Jogging suits [preferably blue] and trainers for outdoor PE

Plimsolls [large apparatus work is done in bare feet]

Jewellery:

In the interests of safety children should not wear any jewellery to school. However, if a child has pierced ears, small studs are permitted which they themselves must remove during PE. If you child cannot remove the studs themselves, no adult may do so therefore please make sure your child is not wearing studs for that day.

Children should also not wear nail varnish or make-up to school.

Long hair must be tied back – the principle being; if it can be tied back, it should be tied back. This policy applies to both boys and girls.
