Where would be a good place to put your leaflet?</i></p>	<p>Design and make a plant pot using a recycled item. How adventurous can you be? </p>	<p>Keep a diary of all the different types of plants you eat over a week. Find out where they are grown and what conditions they need.</p>

What obstacles did they have to overcome to continue?</i> </p>
