In drawing club this week...

We have looked at the book *We are going on an egg hunt*. The children loved looking for all the eggs within the book and this has inspired children to create their own maps and hide little eggs around the classrooms and the Learning Garden. We have also had lots of discussions about how we celebrate Easter and how we might all do things in different ways but this makes it really special for all.

In maths this week...

We have been exploring the world around us. We have been on nature hunts around the school and counted things that we have found. For example, we tried to count and then estimate how many daisies might be on our school field. We have also been comparing distances this week, through our science week experiments. The children made paper rockets and we have been measuring how far these rockets flew.

Other areas of learning...

This week the children have loved being involved in our Science week learning. The children have been looking at the features of animals, and the important job those features have. The children have then used this information to create their own made up animals, using a variety of different features. We have also been making paper rockets, the children enjoyed seeing whose rocket flew the furthest.
