

Attendance reminder



We know attendance is really important and has a direct link to achievement.

What do we want?

We want all our children to be over 97% attendance (less than 5 days absence in the year) and at worst over 95% (less than 10 days absence).

It's amazing to think that if a child is **90% attendance every year for their school life** they essentially missed a whole school year.

Fixed penalty notice information (FPN)

Absence fines charged to parents are £80, or £160 if not paid within 21 days.

Only two fines can be issued to the same parent for the same child within a three-year rolling period. Any second notice will automatically be charged at £160.

New "notices to improve" will also be the "final opportunity for a parent to engage in support and improve attendance before a penalty notice is issued".


