In drawing club this week...

We have looked at the traditional tale, Jack and the Beanstalk. During Explore and Learn time the children have been making beanstalks out of small construction, they have also made some fantastic castles, by either drawing them or creating them with construction. We have also spent a lot of time thinking about what we would like a magic bean to grow into! What would your magic bean grow into?

In maths this week...

We have been learning a new concept; doubles/ doubling. The children have looked at dice patterns and can now confidently tell us whether 2 groups are equal or not. The children have explored doubles by looking at the spots on ladybirds. They have made sure that each wing on the ladybird has the equal amount of spots. Some children have even looked at recording the double number sentences.

Other areas of learning...

This week we have been thinking about how things grow. We have been looking closely at our growing plots in the Learning Garden, and recording any changes that we could see. We have also planted a number of seeds, including beans and sunflowers. The children are going to be looking after these over the next few weeks, and when they are ready they will be moved to our growing plots.

Perhaps you could go on a spring walk with your child. Can they see anything that is changing or starting to grow? You might like to do a drawing of some spring flowers that you see.
