Clothes for activities

For all activities, comfortable, non-restrictive clothes and sensible fastening footwear are essential. Jeans are *not* suitable. We recommend that all clothes and possessions are clearly labelled.

Valuables and electrical appliances

Although Tile Barn is a safe and secure site, we cannot lock tents and do not provide lockers for possessions. Visitors are requested not to bring unnecessary valuables as Tile Barn cannot accept any responsibility for lost or damaged items. Children must not bring any mobile phones with them.

Camping kit list

There will be limited space in your tent, so please keep clothes and baggage to a minimum. Squashy bags are a good idea!

- A plate, bowl and cup – plastic ones are a good idea
- A knife, fork and spoon
- Tea towel
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow and pillow case
- Roll mat – this will help to keep you warm at night and make you comfortable
- Towel
- Wash kit
- Water bottle
- A torch and spare batteries
- Plastic bags for laundry and wet clothes
- Pyjamas
- Warm jumper or fleece and a hat and gloves – **even in the summer it can be cool in the evenings**
- Waterproof jacket and trousers
- A clean change of clothes for each day
- A small day rucksack (for day bag)
- Sun block and sun hat
- Medication - in a named plastic bag
- Wellies – it can get muddy on the camping field and in the forest and for early morning dew!
- Cake - it is tradition that everyone brings a cake (either homemade or shop bought) for all to share
- Optional £5 cash in a named envelop/plastic bag (for the souvenir shop)
