In Drawing club...

This week, we have enjoyed looking at 'The Smegs and the Smoos', learning new vocabulary such as: relationships, nasty, scowling, unique, happiness, antennae. We have thought carefully about creating our own character and setting and then decided where our character might go on their adventure! Ask the children to show you their actions for the vocabulary and to tell you about their story.

In maths this week...

We have been working on many mathematical skills around problem solving. We have been ordering numbers, rolling dice and saying what is one more and one less, playing the track games we created last week and thinking about how we are challenging ourselves with them. We went on to practise subtraction, finding out how many Smoos went swimming and writing number sentences to match.

Other areas of learning...

This week, the children have been immersing themselves in different activities linked to 'The Smegs and the Smoos'. We designed our own aliens and then created them out of plasticine, some children worked together to make the planets look more exciting using loose parts and we had a go at re-telling the story by becoming the characters and acting it out! We have been outside practise different events ready for sports day!


