Year 5 - Space Immersion Day

This week, Year 5 has been fully immersed in our space topic, engaging in a variety of hands-on activities to deepen our understanding of the solar system. To help remember the order and names of the planets, we created our very own mnemonic. We also explored the size of the planets by using fruits, which allowed us to visualise the vast differences in scale.

In another creative activity, we used toilet roll (yes, toilet roll!) to represent the distances between the planets. Each square of toilet roll represented approximately 16 million kilometres, helping us to grasp just how far apart the planets are in our solar system.

To wrap up the day, we had a blast (yes pun intended!) designing and teaching an astronaut fitness routine, which we shared with our fellow 'astronauts.'
