Attendance reminder

Our attendance data is currently **95.7%** in comparison with national attendance data (which is **94.8%).** Well done everyone and keep up the good work.

Every minute counts

Frequent absence can add up to a considerable amount of lost learning and can seriously disadvantage your child in adult life.

- 5 minutes late every day means around 3 ½ days of education are missed
- a score of 90% in a test would be a good result but 90% attendance means that a child will have missed around 100 lessons over a school year.

Attendance during one school year	equals this number of days absent	which is approximately this many weeks absent	which means this number of lessons missed
95%	9 days	2 weeks	50 lessons
90%	19 days	4 weeks	100 lessons
85%	29 days	6 weeks	150 lessons
80%	38 days	8 weeks	200 lessons

We want to work with you to improve attendance so every child has the chance to succeed. Please do arrange an appointment with Mr Matthews or Ms Ley should you have any worries or concerns about attendance.
