Eco Council - Solar Farm Visit

Last week, our Eco Councillors were lucky enough to visit a local solar farm in Five Oaks! They began their visit by identifying biodiversity at the site which is the size of 17 football pitches! The site leader told them all about the farm including what the solar panels are made of and what they weigh. This was followed by a quiz where they discovered that 4.8 million watts of electricity can be generated from the farm and they used their maths skills to work out that there are 20,570 solar panels on the site! They finished off with some wildlife spotting and hearing about the resident sheep who graze the farm!
