In Drawing club...

This week, we have enjoyed looking at 'Where the wild things are', going on an adventure to a far away land full of wonderful creatures. The children have drawn lovely pictures of their own 'wild things' and written imaginative sentences about what they are building and what our characters bedroom turns into.

In maths this week...

We have been finding ways to make the number 5; we have been using the song '5 little kittens' to support our learning- we can sing it to you if you ask! We had to help work out how many were on the bed and how many were hiding under it. We then moved on to looking at the numbers 6, 7, 8 and 9. We noticed we could make them by using '5 and a bit' so the number 8 is 5 and 3 more. We experimented making them in this way using counters and then saying what they have made, for example '7 is made of 5 and 2. 5 and 2 make 7'.

Other areas of learning...

This week, the children have enjoyed all the activities we have done linked to 'Where the wild things are'. We have been making 'wild thing' masks using our cutting, sticking and creative skills. During circle time, we have been thinking about times we have felt wild and what that looked like. We have been enjoying the beautiful weather and today went on a 'wild rumpus' around the school.

How to help at home...

Go on a walk in the woods and see how many animals you spot. With plates of food- can they subitise how many chips/sausages they have. Can they spot '5 and a bit' on their plate?
