#### This week in Drawing Club ...

We have looked at the nursery rhyme 'Five Currant buns'. The children loved singing the song and thinking about what would happen to their cakes in their imaginary cake shops. The children are really getting to grips with Drawing Club and are loving recording their ideas in their own books.

We have practised writing the letters; s, m, o this week.

New vocabulary that the children have been introduced to; kneading, currant and bun.

Don't forget to ask the children what actions go with each of these new words.

#### This week in Maths ...

The children have been helping our counting puppets to learn how to count with care. The children have found it hilarious when the puppets keep making mistakes. The children have been able to explain that to count correctly each object (no matter the size) needs to be given one number, and the final number you say is the total amount.

We have also been working on our listening skills in maths. As we have been using drums! The children had to listen carefully and count how many beats were being played on the drum.

Other learning across the week...

Our role play areas this week have been changed to reflect our Drawing Club rhyme. They have all been turned into cake shops. The children have loved creating recipes, designing their own cakes, and even developing their cutting skills to cut out pictures of different styles of cakes.

#### Ways to help at home ...

Do you have access to scissors at home? If so you can draw some simple lines that your child has to cut along to help develop early cutting skills.
