This week in Drawing Club ...

We have looked at our first Drawing Club book, *The Grumpalump* By Sarah Hayes.

The children have loved this story about a mysterious creature. They have been inspired by the ending (ask your child what the Grumpalump is) and have all had a go at creating hot air balloons to go on adventures.

Our new vocabulary this week - mysterious, tumbled, and inquisitive. It's been wonderful to hear some of these new words appear in the children's independent learning!

This week in Maths ...

We have continued to look at numbers up to 5, and have played a lot of games. Such as 4 or not 4.

For this game our class maths puppets have tried to catch the children out by moving groups of buttons so that they look different and the children have been deciding whether it was still 4.

They have used positional language to explain how they know the total is still 4. For example, "I know it is 4 as there are 2 buttons on top and 2 under those buttons." The children were also able to explain that when it was less than 4 the puppet had taken some of the buttons away.
