Year 6 Victorian Trip

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to share details of an exciting upcoming trip for Year 6 to **Amberley Museum** on **19th November** (please note this is a change of venue from our previous correspondence). This visit will enhance our History topic on the Victorian era, giving children a valuable opportunity to experience first-hand what life was like in our local area during that time.

During the visit, pupils will take part in the "Life & Lime" workshop and experience, where they will discover the hidden history of Amberley Museum and explore what a gruelling daily life was like for workers in the industrial scale chalk pits 100 years ago. They will also carry out a historical investigation into how the pits changed over time, using photographs, artefacts, maps, and oral histories. This will give the children a wonderful insight into our local history and how people lived and worked in the past.

The children will travel by **train** to and from the museum, and the **cost of the trip is £13.02.** This will form part of the **£30 "Trips and Experiences" contribution** for the year.

Important – Trips and Experiences Contribution

Thank you to those families who have already made the **Year 6 £30 Trips and Experiences contribution**. At this stage, only around half of Year 6 parents have made this payment. Unfortunately, <u>this means we</u> currently do not have sufficient funds to cover the full cost of this visit, including entry fees and transport.
