This week in Drawing Club ...

We have looked at the story of *The Three Billy Goats Gruff*. The children really enjoyed this book as it was a familiar story. They have loved using our small world and puppets to retell the story. We have loved hearing all of their voices for the different characters.

The children have also explored making bridges for the goats to travel across. We have used a range of different materials, from lollipop sticks to our large outside construction. We have also been busy creating trolls, some in pencil and some made out of playdough.

The new vocabulary this week - joyus, grotesque and famished

This week in Maths ...

We have been sharing equally between a group of 3. For this we used our characters from the 3 billy goats gruff and pretended that they were going for a picnic in the woods. The children were in charge of making sure that every goat had the same items, therefore making sure that a group of objects was being shared equally between 3.

We have also been looking at ordering our numbers to 5, and having a go at writing these numbers. The children have worked really hard on their formation and we have been impressed with the children's have a go attitude.

Other learning across the week...

This week the children have also enjoyed exploring the theme of remembrance and poppies. The children had a go at drawing poppies and we did potato printing to create some with a different effect. All 3 classes did a 2 minute silence which the children took part in brilliantly!

Ways to help at home ...

Think about our maths from this week and sharing items equally. This works brilliantly at dinner time. Can everyone have the same amount of vegetables?

Reading Records -

In your child's book bag there should be a reading record. This is a place where you can record any stories that you share with your child at home. When your child gets a phonics book you can write in the record how your child got on with the story at home.
