## This week in Drawing Club ...

We have looked at the story *Now now, Bernard*. By David McKee.

The children have loved this story and being able to create their own monsters. They have thought a lot about the features of a monster. For example, how many eyes or would their monsters have wings.

The children have also enjoyed thinking about how they would get the monster out of Bernard's house. The children designed traps and cages and some even planned how to scare the monster with loud noises, like bursting a balloon.

## This week in Maths ...

We have been learning about numbers through song. We introduced the children to the song '5 little peas in a pea pod pressed'.

The children have been using their knowledge of 5 to think how they can make a collection of 5. For example, they have been thinking what would they need to do if the group only had 3 items. How many more would it need? How can we check?

Outside we played 'whats the time Mr wolf' and noticed that there are numbers on our playground track.
