This week in Drawing Club...

We have looked at the story of 'The Elves and Shoemakers'.
The children loved the magic involved in this story and thought about what they would get up to if they had magical elf powers.
The children's drawing and writing has come on so much since September. We have had a focus on writing simple sentences this week, and we have been so impressed!

New Vocabulary - sewing, magical and exhausted

This week in Maths ...

We have been developing our understanding of creating an equal amount. For example, the children have been given a number tile with a numeral on it and they have had to carefully count out that many gems. We have been highlighting the language of equal and talking to the children about the stopping number.

The children have also been looking at putting numbers in the correct order. Thinking about how we count and ensuring that we say each number in the correct order up to 10.

Other learning across the week...

We have enjoyed turning ourselves into elf cartoons. The children have been thinking about all of features they need to make them look like elves.

The children have also been enjoying the slightly better weather because we have been able to get outside more. The children have enjoyed making obstacle courses. Developing their jumping and hopping skills.
