## A Day in the Life of Early Years

We thought it would be helpful to share what a typical morning and afternoon look like in Early Years and how your children are learning throughout the day

### 8:40 - Funky Finger Activities

We start the day with funky finger activities, which focus on developing fine motor skills and strengthening little hands ready for writing.

### Phonics

During phonics, children learn new sounds and practise blending to read words. They read words on their own, in sentences, and within books, building confidence and early reading skills.

### Drawing Club

Drawing Club is a key part of our learning. We explore a story together, focusing on: characters, setting and adventures.

### Explore and Learn

Explore and Learn is our learning-through-play time. Activities are carefully set up to link to the Drawing Club story and current learning.

### Maths

After lunch, we have a whole-class maths input focusing on one area of learning. Recently we have been learning about subitising – “don’t count, say the amount!”

**At the end of the day**, we encourage independence by helping children get themselves ready for home. With visual reminders, they collect their own coats, book bags and belongings.
