## This week in Drawing Club ...

This week we have acted out the story of how a family goes on a bear hunt. The children explored drawing bears and thinking about where they live and what features they have. They have enjoyed joining in with the story while it was read (perhaps you have heard some of it)?

## This week in Maths ...

We have been learning about numbers to 5. We have ordered both numbers and objects. We have looked at missing numbers from a pattern and explained our understanding. The children often worked in pairs to talk first and then feed back to the whole class.

## Other learning across the week...

This week in the hall we went on a bear hunt and acted out moving through grass and mud etc, just like in the story. For our cooking this week we made bear's faces using melting, we talked about how the chocolate changed throughout the process and what caused this to happen.

## Ways to help at home ...

At home, you may wish to go on your own bear hunt and talk about the things that you see.

Play eye spy to practise recognising the initial sounds in words.

When you are shopping can you count how many items (e.g. apples) you have brought?
