night.

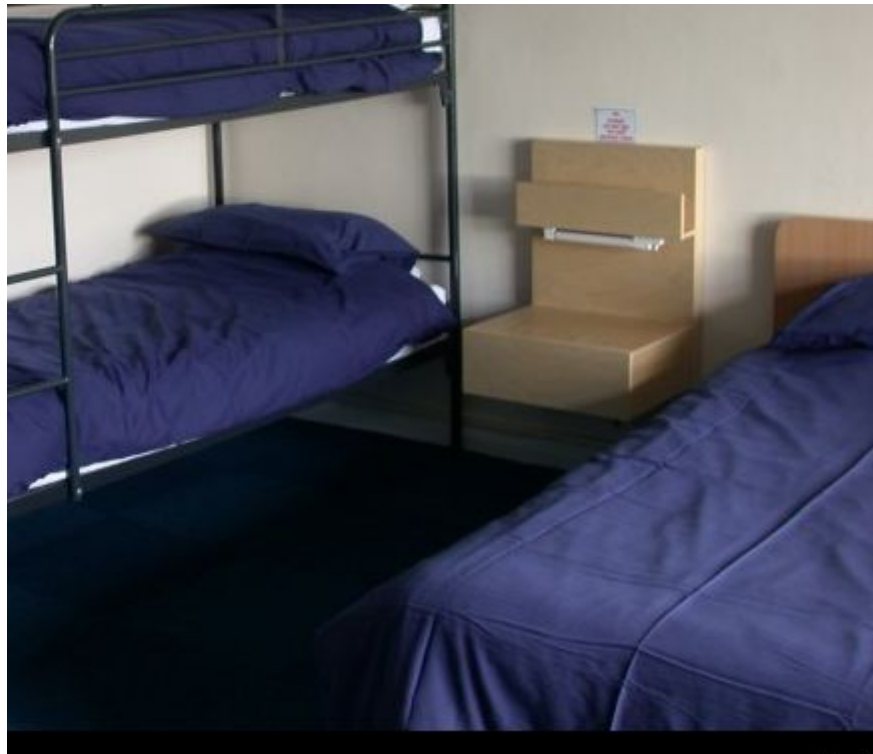
Coach leaves at 9am.

Boys and girls sleep on separate floors.

Adults sleep in separate rooms at each end of the corridor.

Sleeping away from home

Children will be with children and adults they know.

We encourage children to bring teddies/ cuddly toys.

Staff on hand to settle any children feeling a bit homesick.

Any challenges around sleeping are managed sensitively.

Children have a busy day- they are usually tired and/or excited!

Food or allergies

Lodge Hill is nut free. Special diets catered for – please get the medical forms returned asap when they come out to you.

Food is home cooked and delicious.

Gentle encouragement/peer support.

Busy children get hungry!

Medical issues/ disabilities

Lodge Hill caters for many disabilities, and we ensure correct ratio of staff to children.

Lead teacher will keep records of all medical needs and dispense any medicines.

We will prepare children in advance, especially those who may need additional support. Talk to us if you are worried.
