This week in Drawing Club ...

This week we have enjoyed reading the story Peace at last. The children have thinking about their favourite part of the story. They have been developing their understanding of nocturnal animals as well as thinking about where different animals live.

This week in Maths ...

This week in maths the children have been investigating numbers to 5. Using playdough, the children have been creating the numerals and trying to create these numbers using tens frames. They have also been ordering the numbers to 10 on a number line. The children have also been exploring the concept of height this week and on Friday we ordered our bears from shortest to tallest.

Other learning across the week...

The children have been exploring colour mixing this week, they used these colours to paint their own bear. They have thought about where their bear might live and used the construction areas to build them. Just like Daddy Bear in our story, we have been using our sense of hearing this week to see what sounds we can hear around the school environment

Ways to help at home ...

Have a look outside the window and see what animals you can see, talk to your child about where they live.

Collect items from around the house, can you order them from the shortest to the tallest. Get your child to talk about how they did it.

Share animals stories with your child. Talk about what happened in the story and what was their favourite part.
