




Book of the Week!


Ellie from Anderson Class in Year 5 has chosen **Amari and the Nightbrothers** by B.B. Alston.

Learning Gear of the Week!

Our **Self Managers** learning gear helps children grow into confident, independent learners. In school, children are encouraged to take risks, knowing that mistakes are a normal and important part of learning. They learn how to manage their behaviour, attitudes and emotions so they are ready to learn, as well as how to organise their time and resources effectively. Children develop an understanding of their own strengths and how to use them, while learning that effort, resilience and a positive mindset help them succeed. We also celebrate that everyone is unique, and that being ourselves is something to be proud of.

At home you could:

Encourage independence: Give children small responsibilities and chances to do things for themselves.

Praise effort, not just results: Talk positively about trying hard, persevering and learning from mistakes.

Normalise mistakes: Share times when you've made a mistake and what you learned from it.

Support organisation: Help children plan their time, prepare resources and follow routines.

Talk about strengths: Help children recognise what they're good at and how they can use those strengths.

Promote a positive mindset: Use language like "*You can't do this yet*" to reinforce growth and resilience.

Celebrate individuality: Remind children that everyone is different and that being themselves is something to celebrate.

Children who recently received a Headteacher's Award enjoyed their well-earned reward time today, taking part in an exciting session on our gym bars. The children showed great enthusiasm and confidence as they made the most of this special opportunity.



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
