Year 6 Imperial War Museum trip - Thursday 26th February

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to share details of an exciting upcoming trip for Year 6 to **the Imperial War Museum (London)** on **26th February**. This visit will enhance our History topic on the Second World War, giving children a valuable opportunity to experience engaging, hands-on exhibits and learn about life for citizens during this time period.

Costings

The cost of the trip is £8.53 which will be taken from your **£30 'Trips and Experiences' contribution** for the year.

Timings

We will be travelling to and from the Imperial War Museum by train. Children are to arrive at school at **8:25am** via the **Key Stage Two hall**. We will then walk down to Billingshurst train station together. Our return train arrives back to Billingshurst at 4:15pm, so we should be back in school by **4:30pm**. Please collect your child at 4:30pm unless we already have permission for your child to walk home independently at the end of the school day. We will let you know if there have been any significant delays.

Clothing

Children are to wear their normal school uniform. There is a walk from the station to the museum so please ensure they have suitable shoes and a waterproof coat.

Lunch

Please ensure that your child has a packed lunch to take with them in a bag. They must also bring a water bottle and may wish to bring an additional snack. If your child usually receives free school meals, then a Chartwells packed lunch will be provided for them.
