




# EYFS Newsletter - Monday 9th March 2026

## In drawing club this week...

We looked at the book *Rosie's Walk* by Pat Hutchins. The children really enjoyed this text as it led to them using their imagination to think about how Rosie could get away from sneaky the fox. New vocabulary inspired by the text - sneaky, besides and stroll.



## In maths this week...

We have been developing our understanding of addition. We used a part part whole model to combine two amounts to discover the total. The children have been looking at and using the symbols + and =. We have also been exploring positional and directional language.

## This week we have been learning...

To develop our artistic skills by creating our own pictures inspired by Rosie's Walk. The children used water colours and a fine black marker to add detail. The children also had a fabulous time celebrating World Book Day! They enjoyed talking to the class about their favourite character and all had a go at writing about who they dressed up as.
