




EYFS Newsletter - Friday 13th March 2026

Ambition Belonging Courage

In drawing club this week...

We looked at the traditional tale, Jack and the beanstalk. Our new vocabulary inspired by the text this week has been massive, towering, stem and mistake. This text has inspired our learning this week about plants and seeds. Look out for our plants growing in the Learning Garden.



In maths this week...

We have had great fun exploring estimating and measuring. The children were very excited to discover the giant had apparently visited our classroom and left behind enormous footprints. The children worked together to measure the length of the footprints using cubes. They carefully lined up the cubes and counted how many were needed to match the length of the footprints.

This week we have been learning...

In the creative area, the children practised observational drawing by carefully looking at real flowers and drawing what they could see. We talked about the different parts of a flower, we worked together to label them, including the petals, stem, leaves and roots. In our construction area, the children used a range of building materials to design and build castles. They worked together to plan their structures, thinking about how to make tall towers and strong walls.

How to help at home...

You could go on a flower hunt with your child and see what different flowers you can find.

Encourage your child to draw the flowers and see if they label the parts.

Try printing flowers at home using everyday objects such as cut up vegetables, bottle tops and sponges.

Use blocks, lego, cardboard boxes to build a castle together. Encourage your child to describe their creations.
