




EYFS Newsletter - Friday 20th March 2026

In drawing club this week...

In maths this week...

The children practised doubling and developed their understanding of odd and even numbers. They also explored sorting and grouping objects, helping them to develop their early maths reasoning skills. Alongside this, they continued to practise counting to strengthen their confidence and fluency.

This week we have been learning...

The children have engaged in a variety of hands on activities that supported their learning across the curriculum. They enjoyed making paper flowers and helped to look after the garden, developing creativity and an understanding of the natural world. They have experienced early measuring skills by measuring the distance the cars travelled. In addition the children took part in a fun run to support Comic Relief, promoting teamwork and raising awareness of helping others.

How to help at home...

Supporting counting during everyday life, count the stairs, sort the socks by colour or size, or talk about the shapes you see around the house. Get outside and have a go at measuring the distance you can jump, hop or throw a ball. Whilst walking take time to notice the signs that spring is here. Can you name any of the flowers that have started to grow?
