In drawing club this week...

We looked at 'We're going on an egg hunt'. The new vocabulary we explored this week was gather, treasure, travelling and celebrate. This book inspired our easter themed week. We have been extending our sentences and using more complex vocabulary to express our ideas.



In maths this week...

We have been continuing to develop our knowledge of doubling this week. We now know that doubling is when we add the same amount again. We have been using numicon plates to support our learning. For example, we have been placing 2 identical numicon pieces together to discover that double 3 is 6.

This week we have been learning...

In our outdoor learning environment this week, we have been going on our own egg hunt. We have also been observing the changes around us and discussing how we know spring is coming. We have also been busy creating colourful and creative easter cards using a range of materials to express our ideas. We have been learning about Easter and what it means to different people.

How to help at home...

When out and about, point out signs of spring such as flowers, new leaves and changes in the weather. Ask questions such as 'What can you see?' or 'How do you know it's spring?'. Make Easter cards using paper, crayons, stickers or recycled materials. Talk together about who they would like to give their cards to and help them practise explaining their ideas.
