

Writing

As readers and writers, we will continue to explore a variety of high-quality texts. We will use these texts and other stimuli to inspire our writing. Linked to our science, we will write to inform about the composition of blood. We will then use these skills to write about our circulatory system and the role it plays in the human body.

Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will be revising our core arithmetic skills, ensuring we build our fluency. We will also develop our mathematical reasoning both verbally and through written reasoning. We will develop our understanding of analysing data and statistics, linking this to our science investigations and computing.

Geography

As Geographers, we will build on all of our knowledge so far to develop our own geographical enquiry. In teams, we will create enquiry questions and plan our research before conducting our fieldwork in the local area. We will collect data to analyse and present our findings.

Science

As scientists, we will learn about the components of blood by making 'blood smoothies'. We will then research, plan and set up an investigation involving the human circulatory system, describing the functions of the heart. We will repeat measurements for accuracy and record our findings using appropriate scientific language.

Computing

As computer scientists, we will be exploring coding and writing simple coding instructions. Once we have developed these skills, we will be designing and writing our own code using Microbits.

RE

As spiritual learners, we will look at right and wrong and at how other religions address this. We will then explore how current groups and organisations work together to help humanity.

Lifeskills

In Lifeskills, we develop our understanding of what respect looks like and how to show it to others. We will explore how stereotypes can influence ideas and opinions, identifying and discussing different examples. We will then develop skills to manage conflict by creating a simple resolution guide and recognising situations where conflict may arise.

French

As linguists, we will work on both verbal and written skills, speaking with increased confidence and accurate pronunciation. We will build our vocabulary to use within our French conversational speaking. This will be learnt through a focus topic on animal habitats.

Physical Education

As athletes, we will be developing our jumping and throwing techniques. We will be throwing javelins, discus and shot-put, all in preparation for Sports Day at the end of year. In cricket, we will focus on our bowling, batting and fielding skills. We will also learn the rules and tactics of cricket, working to put these into game scenarios.
