As gymnasts, we will be building sequences by linking different actions, perform balances and create our own balances. We will work with a partner to complete a sequence working in unison. As athletes, we will use our leading arm to help throw, move in different ways to show balance, coordination and agility and we will use this to perform competitively.

As members of the school community, we will be learning all about money and how it is used in society. We will talk about what money is used for and how it is earned. We will talk about the importance of looking after our money and we will discuss different jobs that people do.

As scientists, we will learn about the structure of plants and trees, and what they are used for. We will explore the outdoor area in school, to identify various common plants, trees and wild flowers. We will learn more about evergreen and deciduous trees.

Our Curious Quests adventures will continue but we will be meeting the Faithful Friends! We will be solving problems, discovering new places, and learning the value of teamwork and kindness along the way. As writers we will be focusing on sentence structure, vocabulary development, editing and improving our work and using different punctuation.

As artists, we will be developing our observational drawing skills. We will use different techniques to make marks, textures and shades.

As Historians, we will be learning about how explorers have changed the world. We will be looking into the journeys of Christopher Columbus, Mary Kingsley, Matthew Henson and Dame Ellen MacArthur.

As mathematicians, we will be recognising coins and continuing to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will be measuring using a ruler, and using numbers 0-20. We will be learning about position and direction including full turn, half turns and quarter turns. We will be learning how to tell the time to half past and O'clock.

As computer scientists, we will be creating our own animations to create a fairy tale story. We will create our own backgrounds using drawing apps to upload our pictures into our animations.
