

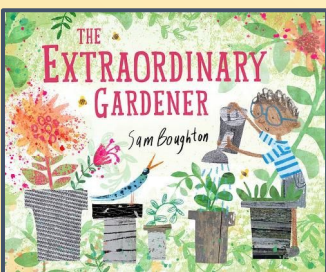


EYFS Newsletter - Friday 17th April 2026

In drawing club this week...

We looked at 'The Extraordinary Gardener'. The new vocabulary we explored this week was; extraordinary, skyscraper, scent and daydreamer. This book has inspired us to look at our garden area and the children have been noticing all the tiny things that are starting to grow..



In maths this week...

We have been thinking about how to count larger quantities of objects and things that cannot be moved, such as bangs on a drum. We have subitised by spotting smaller groups and adding them together. Counted as we move a large number of objects and crossed off the objects as we carefully counted each one. We are not working on counting things up to 20.

This week we have been learning...

In our outdoor learning environment this week, we have been excited by some huge bags of bark being delivered. This has been exciting to spread around and also means that the slide is able to be used again. We have been using our cutting and joining skills to create spring flowers in different ways. In our writing we have been thinking more about using a capital letter to start a sentence and to show a word using a finger space.

How to help at home...

When out and about, see what colours you can see in the environment. In our book this week Joe the little boy changed his grey world colourful by growing plants and giving them to others. Look at the vegetables you are eating, discuss which part of the plant they come from. Is it a root, a stem, the bulb or the leaves? Are the vegetables raw or have they been cooked?
