In drawing club this week...

We have had a story that has been incredibly popular with all of the children. They have enjoyed correcting us when we say the dinosaur names incorrectly and have loved developing their dinosaur knowledge.



In maths this week...

We have revisited making 5 we have used our understanding to think about making 6 to 9. We have used blocks and other resources to show how two numbers can be added to make a larger number and to investigate different combinations. When exploring making 10 we have used our fingers to support our learning and played 'Don't burn the sausages'.

This week we have been learning...

About what makes a good friend. The children have thought about their own friendships and how they support each other. We have read lots of stories about friendships and also about dinosaurs. We have continued to look carefully at what is happening in nature. The children have been amazed at how much the sunflower seeds they planted last week have grown and this has made them want to plant more in the garden area of our Learning Garden.

How to help at home...

If you have a pot or area in the garden, why not plant some seeds. Something like radish and lobelia grow quickly, others take a little longer. Encourage your child to write a little (it is fine if it is not perfect) maybe a shopping list or a note to another member of the family. Count familiar objects. This can be a little challenge. How many windows on our house? How many steps from the bedroom to the bathroom? Perhaps they could get you to count something.
