## In drawing club this week...

Following on from 'Dig Dig Dinosaur' last week, which was quite factual. This week we enjoyed 'The Hugasaurus' which tells the tale of a 'cute' dinosaur that realises he likes a hug. The children have enjoyed continuing to find out, draw and write about all things dinosaur.



## In maths this week...

We have looked at which two numbers make 10. The children have viewed different ways of showing 10 or not 10. We have ordered numbers where some are missing and thought about numbers that are 'quite close' to another which supports understanding of value and order. The children have been helping the maths puppet who often gets confused when he/she is thinking about numbers.

## This week we have been learning...

We have been lucky to have some of the YR Six children visiting us and our children have enjoyed spending time with them as they have helped build dens and support imaginative games.

Many of the children have been observing the flowers and insects in the garden. They have learnt to watch but not touch as it is very easy to damage or hurt things in our environment.

## How to help at home...

Look at the numbers on houses. Are they in order? If not which number is missing? Where might the missing numbers be?

Talk about favourite stories and why they are so liked tell your child about a story you enjoyed as a child. Perhaps you still have the book. This is also a lovely activity to do with grandparents and aunts/uncles.

Talk about colours of flowers, are they new colours like maroon or turquoise?

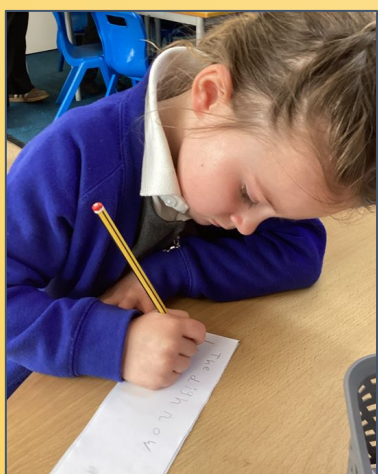
