

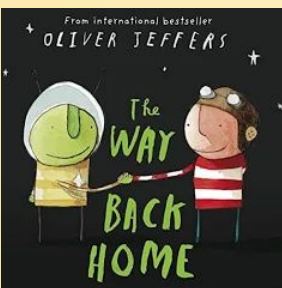

In drawing club this week...

We have continued our focus on space. We have explored the idea of aliens and martians with the children designing their own alien. This is a lovely story about finding friendship in an unlikely place. It has made us wonder what may be out there and what it might look like.



In maths this week...

We have done a lot of data collecting involving favourite fruit, colours and flavours. The children have looked at the information and spoken about things they have noticed. We have used language such as fewer and more, favourite and most popular. Towards the end of the week they have been able to say how many more or less a certain item had. We have also been practising counting in 1s and 10s.

This week ...

The weather has not been so nice so we have been using our lovely covered area. The falling rain has led us to use words such as drip and pour, splash and ripple. You may have noticed that we have been having a move round in the garden area so that each area is set up to make it easier for the children to access resources more independently. In art we have explored making planets using different techniques such as painting with a balloon and using shaving foam.

How to help at home...

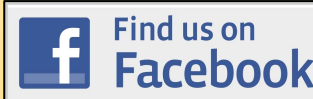

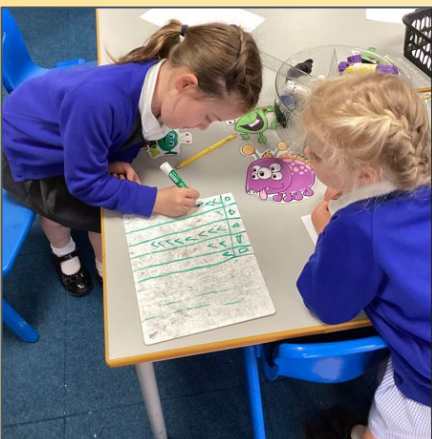
