

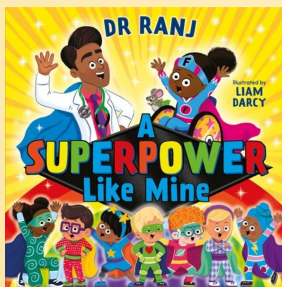

This week ...

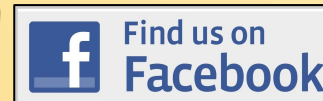

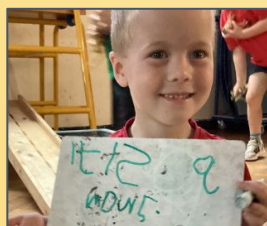
