

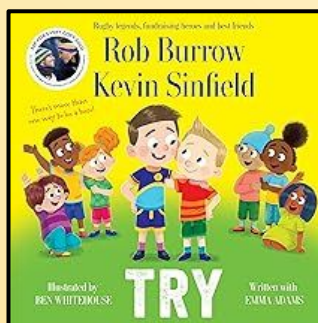

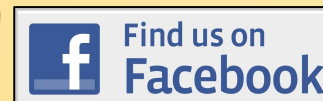
This week ...
