Dear Parents/Carers

Lodge Hill Residential Visit – 2 days and 1 night, 5th April 2022

We are pleased to confirm the residential trip to Lodge Hill, near Pulborough will take place in April for Year 5 pupils. The children will stay for one night at Lodge Hill together as one year group which is a change to the way we used to run the trip. We think this will be beneficial as a bonding experience across the three classes. The purpose of the trip is to enhance the curriculum for the children. They will also benefit from team building activities and a variety of creative experiences.

The total cost will be **£117**, which includes accommodation, food, transport, insurance and all instructor led activities. The board and lodging element of the cost is chargeable and the rest is a voluntary contribution. Parents are not obliged to make a contribution, but it is probable that if insufficient monies are received the trip will have to be cancelled. We would like every single child in Year 5 to take part in this valuable experience so, if you are concerned about affordability, please contact me in confidence through the school office.

To secure your son/daughter's place please pay a deposit of **£37.00** by **Tuesday 1st February**.

The balance of the cost can be made in two further payments of **£40.00** on the **28th February** and **28th March**. Alternatively you can pay the full amount at any time if you wish. We ask that you pay this through ParentPay, where you can also give your consent for the trip. Please call the office if you have lost your activation letter or would like help getting started.
