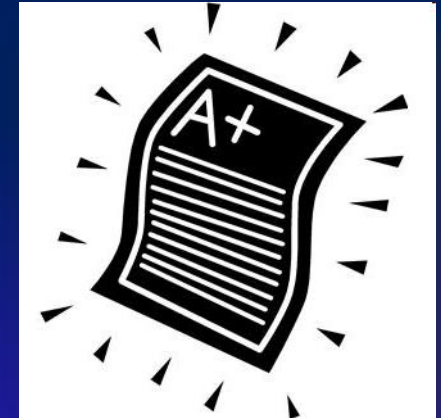
# SATS
