In Year 5 we aim to:


- ensure a smooth transition from Year 4

Daily Routines

School book bags should be brought in every day. This should always contain:
your child's home school liaison books in case we need to get a message home to you or you need to communicate with us
your child's spelling log book (where you can help support your child with any spelling words they need to focus on learning)
your child's reading journal (where you can encourage your child to read independently at home and comment on their books)
We expect them to bring in a water bottle to keep in class, clearly labelled with their name. (Children will have access to the water fountain nearest to their classroom.)
