Dear Parents / Carers



I hope you are all well and keeping safe in these challenging times. You should all now have had a telephone call from your child's teacher and the team report that these have been well received and helpful for them too. If you have not had a call, apart from Argentina class, then we have been trying to contact you. Please email us with up to date phone numbers if this has changed, and check your emails. If we cannot make contact you will receive a letter in the post asking you to call us. We need to make contact in one form or another as part of our safeguarding procedures whilst most children are not in school.

Attached is our guidance for keeping children safe on line during the time when they are learning at home – do have a look through this and, if you have any particular worries, let us know and we will do what we can to support you.

A few parents have asked us if we can do class zoom meetings. I have given this some thought, and liaised with our team of teachers to ensure I have their views. This is something we are not going to provide at the moment and this is for two reasons. The first is inclusion – if we cannot be sure that ALL children would be included then we would not want to proceed with something that may exclude certain children. The second reason is privacy and safeguarding. Such a meeting would reveal who was in school and who was not – with the categorisations of children allowed to be in school to include vulnerable children, this would be a breach of confidentiality and their privacy. There was such an issue in another local authority which was deemed to have breached the child's privacy when other parents questioned the child's validity to be in school. You are, of course, free to set up zoom meetings with other families and friends but it is something we will not be providing. Thank you for your understanding.

Thank you again for all the lovely messages sent to the teachers and teams about the home learning and support being offered. Remember, we are here to help so do get in touch. We may not always be able to solve the problem but we may know who can!
