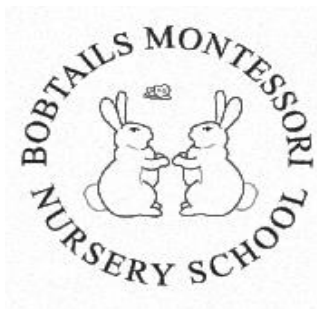


Welcome to Reception at Billingshurst Primary School

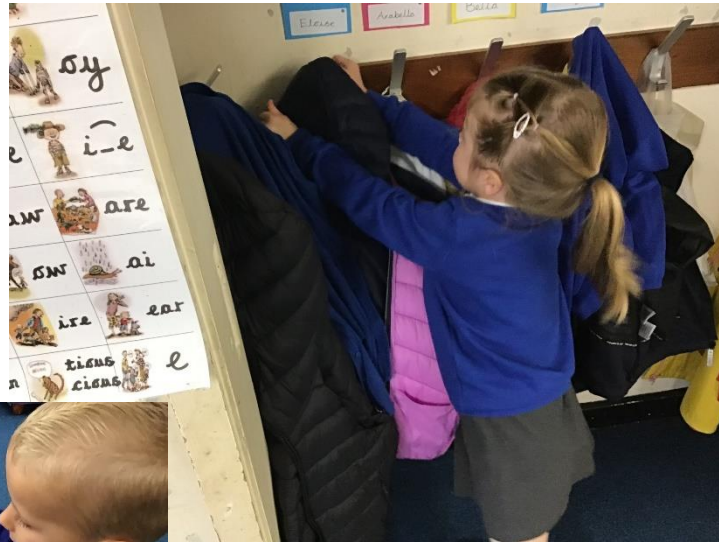
